A Letter From the Director/Producer Jonelle Kop

It's a true pleasure to be back directing and producing such an iconic show as Orson Welles, *War of the Worlds*! Having such a large cast allows us to bring back some old faces and add some new ones to join our regulars.



We are reproducing the original radio show with all of the live sound effects for this fabulous performance. We are also adding our own twist to it by portraying some of the chaos in the community as they listened to the radio show. In researching those events to write that script, I found it amazing, but not truly surprising, how people reacted so dramatically to the show.

The adage, it's on the radio therefore it must be true, was very prevalent back in the 30s as radio was the main source of immediate news. And the panic that Orson Welles radio show created, changed the world forever. Yet even today, how easy it is for perceptions of reality to be changed one way or the other by what we see on television and internet, read in the newspapers or hear on the radio. So, we relearn the lesson

Mr. Welles taught us, don't believe everything you hear, or everything people tell you without verifying for yourself! Especially when it comes to aliens! LOL.



Or maybe the more appropriate correlation is what happened just a month ago... the 30+ terrifying minutes our fellow Hawaiians suffered though believing that an atomic bomb was heading their way... because of a broadcast they heard on the radio and on their cell phones... and believed it was true.



The smiles and the laughter of friends and neighbors, makes it well worth the effort of relentless rehearsing for Russell. He hopes you enjoy the show.




Jim Enright as "Butch" and "The Stranger"



Elaine Lanzarotta as "Hazel"


Elaine is excited to be a part of this wonderful recreation of a historical radio show. This is her first on stage experience ever, and she is enjoying it immensely.
